Mr. Blinoff was a past President of the Music Booster Club and had a vision to establish a scholarship fund for deserving students in the instrumental music department. Grants up to \$300 will be awarded to graduating senior students who have been active in an instrumental music performing group at Crescenta Valley High School and wish to continue their music education at a college, university, or conservatory of music.

Grant requirements:

- Graduating senior from Crescenta Valley High School (Clark Magnet High School students may apply if they have been active in a CVHS instrumental music performing group)
- Member of a CVHS instrumental music performing group for 3 out of 4 years and currently enrolled in an instrumental music class. (If transferring from another high school, you must have been in an instrumental music group at that high school).
- Minimum GPA 3.0
- Have declared and been accepted into a music major/minor program at an accredited College, University, or Conservatory of Music. Students who are not majoring or minoring in music must describe how they will continue their music education.
