

Program Notes

Gladiators - gladiators were the sports heroes of their day. Potential gladiators were typically picked from prisoners of war, slaves, sentenced criminals, and occasionally volunteers. They were such an investment for gladiator would typically fight no more than three times per year. Fights were not generally to the death, acknowledged defeat by raising a finger, the audience could decide whether the loser should live or die. A grant both to live and fight for their amusement in the future. A gladiator who won several fights was allowed they were technically slaves, many successful gladiators even managed to win their freedom. Although large followings of citizen-class women, who apparently saw them as sexual objects. This may be one reason that many types of gladiators fought bare-chested.

Schindler's List - "Oscar Schindler rose to the highest level of humanity, walked through the bloody mud of the Holocaust without soiling his soul, his compassion, his respect for human life - and gave his Jews a second chance at life. He miraculously managed to do it and pulled it off by using the very same talents that made him a war profiteer - his flair for presentation, bribery, and grand gestures."

Imagine - As half of the legendary Lennon-McCartney songwriting team, John Lennon heavily influenced the development of rock music, leading it towards more advanced multi-layered arrangements, mature lyrical sentiments, and musical eclecticism. He is recognized as one of the greatest music icons of the 20th century and many of his songs, such as "Imagine", "Strawberry Fields Forever" and "In My Life", are ranked among the best songs in popular music history. In 2002, the BBC conducted a vote to discover the 100 Greatest Britains of all time, and the British public voted Lennon into 8th place.

Irish Party - The Irish diaspora consists of Irish emigrants and their descendants in countries such as the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, states of the Caribbean, and continental Europe. The diaspora was caused by a number of factors, including political and religious oppression, joblessness, and hunger in a sometimes-harsh land. Like immigrants of any nationality, these people overcame hazards, hardships and prejudice for the chance to establish a new start in a new land.

Lucrietia MacEvil - Lucretia MacEvil was performed by Blood, Sweat, and Tears, an American music group, formed in New York City in 1967, which fused jazz and rock or pop music into a hybrid genre that came to be known as "jazz-rock". They are considered, by and large, to be the first or among the first of this genre of music. Somewhat unlike what became known as "jazz fusion" or simply as "fusion" (which often tended more toward virtuosic displays of electronic experimentation and amodal music), Blood, Sweat & Tears' sound was more a merging of the varied stylings of rock, pop and R&B/soul music with big band or combo jazz.

Superstition, Stevie Wonder - Stevie Wonder (born 1950 as Stevland Judkins, later changed to Stevland Morris) is an American singer, songwriter, producer, musician, humanitarian and social activist. Wonder has recorded more than 30 Top 10 hits, won 24 Grammy Awards (a record for a living artist), also one for lifetime achievement, and been inducted into both the Rock and Roll and Songwriters halls of fame. Blind from infancy, Wonder has become one of the most successful and well-known artists on the Motown label, with nine U.S. #1 hits to his name and album sales totaling more than 100 million units. A multi-instrumentalist, Wonder plays the druns, bass guitar, congas, and most famously the piano, harmonica and keyboards. Many critics refer to the quality of his work and its versatility as being indicative of musical genius.

James Bond - Commander James Bond, CMG, RNVR is an agent of the international arm of the British Secret Service headquartered in London in a tall, grey building overlooking Regent's Park. Under the cover name "Universal Exports" and later "Transworld Consortium", Bond's fictional British Secret Service starting in 1995 takes on the actual name of the UK's Secret Intelligence Service, commonly known as MI6. As an agent of the Secret Service, Bond holds code number "007". The 'double-O' prefix indicates his discretionary license to kill in the performance of his duties.

Charlie Brown - Charlie Brown is the child hero of the newspaper comic strip Peanuts. Charlie Brown is a lovable loser who dreams of hitting the game-winning home run but usually strikes out. For 50 years, Charlie Brown and his dog Snoopy appeared in newspapers around the world. A few of Charlie Brown's traits have become particularly famous: his phrase of dismay, "Good grief!", his unrequited love for the unseen little redhaired girl, his philosophical discussions with his blanket-carrying chum Linus; and his annual attempts to kick a football held by Linus's sneaky sister Lucy. Schulz drew the strip right up until his death in 2000; since that time it has continued in reruns in hundreds of newspapers.

Mozart - Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart is among the most significant and enduringly popular composers of European classical music. His enormous output includes works that are widely acknowledged as pinnacles of symphonic, chamber, piano, operatic, and choral music. Many of his works are part of the standard concert repertory and are widely recognized as masterpieces of the classical style. Even his influence in popular music is monumental. The leader of the rock group Queen, Freddie Mercury, is well-known for his Mozart-affected piano playing.

Zorro - Zorro, Spanish for fox, is the secret identity of Don Diego de la Vega (originally Don Diego Vega), a fictional nobleman and master swordsman living in Spanish-era California. He defends the Californio people from the corrupt tyranny of the Spanish governor, proving himself to be much too foxlike and cunning for the bumbling authorities to catch. He was created by pulp writer Johnston McCulley, and first made his appearance in The Curse of Capistrano in 1919. Zorro wears a black costume with a cape, a small flat-brimmed hat and a black cowl mask, in addition, his favored weapon is a rapier, which he often uses to leave his distinctive emblem, a large 'Z' made from three quick slashes.

Outra Coisa - means "Another Thing" in Brazilian, by composer Moacir Santos, a modern musical hero of Brazil. His works do not fit into any period of Brazilian popular music. While the world was drawn to the Bossa Nova of the 1960's, Moacir was writing film scores with a distinctly African flavor. Trumpeter Wynton Marsalis called Moacir a "living encyclopedia" of jazz and compared him to Thelonius Monk and Beethoven for his inventiveness, and to Duke Ellington for his orchestral clarity. Santos is retired and now lives in Pasadena.

Spider-Man - Spider-Man's superhero powers include the ability to cling to walls and ceilings, super-human strength and agility, and an extra-sensory "Spider Sense". Stan Lee's early Spider-Man stories broke new ground by attempting to relate to readers with a younger character who balanced his personal struggles with his heroic exploits. His alter ego, Peter Parker, grows up dealing with everyday problems (love, school, work, rent, etc.), while Spider-Man, devotes himself to fighting injustice, driven by the realization that "with great power there must also come great responsibility. He has become one of the world's most popular, enduring and well-recognized "friendly, neighborhood" hero.

Wicked - Wicked, loosely based on by Gregory Maguire's book, Wicked: The Life and Times of the Wicked Witch of the West, is an alternative story to L. Frank Baum's classic book The Wonderful Wizard of Oz. Set in the days prior to Dorothy's arrival from Kansas, the story explores the idea that the infamous antagonist we call the Wicked Witch of the West was misconstrued and victimized. At Shiz University, the intelligent greenskinned woman, Elphaba Thropp meets beautiful and ambitious Galinda Upland (who later becomes Glinda the Good Witch) when the two become roommates. Their lives intertwine, and their friendship struggles to endure extreme personality differences, opposing viewpoints, rivalry over the same love-interest, and of course, Elphaba's eventual tragic fall from grace.

Forrest Gump - The story follows the life of simple Forrest Gump and his meeting with the love of his life Jenny. The film chronicles his accidental experiences with some of the most important people and events in America from the late 1950's through the 1970's including a meeting with Elvis Presley, JFK, Lyndon Johnson, Richard Nixon, fighting in Vietnam, etc. Forrest becomes representative of the baby boomer generation having walked through life blindly.

Shaft - John Shaft is a fictional character created by screenwriter/novelist Ernest Tidyman as a sort of African-American answer to Ian Fleming's James Bond. He was portrayed by Richard Roundtree in the 1971 film, and by Samuel L. Jackson in the 2000 remake. The blurb on the paperback on which the original film is based states Shaft is "Hotter than Bond, cooler than Bullitt."

Family Guy - Family Guy is an American animated sitcom created in 1999. The title character is Peter Griffin, an inept blue-collar worker head of a middle class family frequently beset by the consequences of his foolish antics. Family Guy's brand of humor is notable for the usually brief, frequently nonsensical cutaways (usually featuring oddball pop culture references) and flashbacks to various points in history, geography, and reality involving the characters and their ludicrous actions.

Superman - is SUPERMANII What more needs to be said! J Superman is a fictional character and superhero of DC Comics who first appeared in Action Comics #1 in 1938 and is considered the first character to embody the particular combination of traits that characterize the modern superhero. Superman was born Kal-El on the planet Krypton and, as an infant, was rocketed to Earth by Jor-El, his scientist father, moments before Krypton exploded. The ship landed on Earth outside the town of Smallville, where young Kal-El was discovered and adopted by the amiable Jonathan and Martha Kent. As he grew, he discovered that he possessed powers far beyond those of mortal men and women and resolves to use them to help others. When not fighting the forces of evil as Superman, he lives disguised among humanity as "mild-mannered" Clark Kent, a reporter for the Metropolis Daily Planet. Clark works alongside reporter Lois Lane, with whom he is romantically involved.

Heroes of the Small Screen - "Heroes of the Small Screen" is a compilation of contemporary American heroes, from Hill Street Blues, The Rockford Files, Law and Order, Magnum P.I., The "A" Team, and the Greatest American Hero.

I Wan'na Be Like You - The Jungle Book is the nineteenth animated feature in the Disney animated features canon. "I Wan'na Be Like You" is sung by Jungle Book characters King Louie the Ape and Baloo the Bear to Mowgli, their human charge.

Hunting Wabbits - The fictional cartoon character Elmer J. Fudd is one of the most famous Looney Tunes/Merrie Melodies characters. His aim is to shoot Bugs Bunny, but he generally ends up seriously injuring himself instead. In every episode that he is in, he always says the phrase: "Be vewy vewy quwiet I'm hunting wabbits ... hehehehehe!"

O Brother, Where Are Thou? - Very loosely based on Homer's "The Oddysey", O Brother, Where Art Thou? is a musical comedy film written and directed by Joel and Ethan Coen, set in Mississippi during the Great Depression (specifically, 1937). The hero of the film is a dapper, smooth-talking con man called Ulysses Everett McGill. Ulysses escapes from a chain gang and brings along the two fellow prisoners chained to him with the promise of recovering buried treasure from a heist, in truth, he only wants to get back to his wife before she marries someone else.

The Incredibles - Bob Parr, formerly the superhero 'Mr. Incredible', lives a quiet suburban life with his wife Helen, formerly Elastigirl, and their two super-powered children (and their baby, whose superpowers are yet to be awakened). Bored with this mundane life, he occasionally sneaks out to fight crime and protect the innocent. Upon receiving a mysterious benefactor's invitation to be a hero again, Mr. Incredible leaps at the opportunity, However, the "benefactor" turns out to be a villain who carries a grudge, and is out to destroy Mr. Incredible. His family must heroically unite to save their father and the world!
