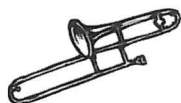

Americana



What is Americana? Sometimes it is hard to define what is uniquely American, yet we always know it when we see it. In this context, it refers to the literature, art, cuisine, history, objects, and especially tonight, the music that reflect the culture of the United States.

People often say something is "as American as apple pie." What about other foods? Are hamburgers all-American? Of course. "French" fries? Yes, please! Steak on the grill? Yes, yes, yes! Many American foods have their roots in other cultures, yet we have made them uniquely our own, from Tex-Mex to "California Cuisine." New Orleans Cajun cookin' is not to be found any place else. Foods indigenous to North America, like turkey, potatoes, sweet potatoes, corn, and squash, combine with other cuisines and lead to amazing new "American" food: slow-cooked barbecue, crab cakes, potato chips, chocolate chip cookies, fried chicken, pizza, and hot dogs.

In literature, Americana is captured in books such as Washington Irving's *The Legend of Sleepy Hollow* or Mark Twain's *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*. Popular literary genres such as the Western and hardboiled crime fiction were also developed in the United States.

To those in other countries, Americana might best be expressed by our popular culture. It is found in nearly every medium: Mickey Mouse, Barbie, Elvis Presley, Madonna, Babe Ruth, Baseball, American football, Basketball, Jazz, Hip Hop, *The Simpsons*, Michael Jackson, Superman, Indiana Jones, *Sesame Street*, *Catch-22*—these ideas, names, and phrases have joined more tangible American products in spreading across the globe.

Tonight, though, we are celebrating the music of America. It has its roots in many traditions but has its own unique and distinct character. Americana refers to music that somehow identifies, inspires, and encapsulates the heart of tradition and the American experience. Folk, country, bluegrass, rap, jazz, zydeco, rock & roll, the blues, hip hop, and ethnic American music all meet that description. Tonight's music selections include television show themes, pieces from several Broadway musicals, traditional folk songs, jazz, swing, big band, patriotic tunes and a classic American story, told in verse and accompanied by the Concert Band.

Please join us as we celebrate America and those things that uniquely signify American life and culture this evening.

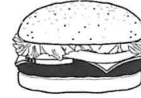
