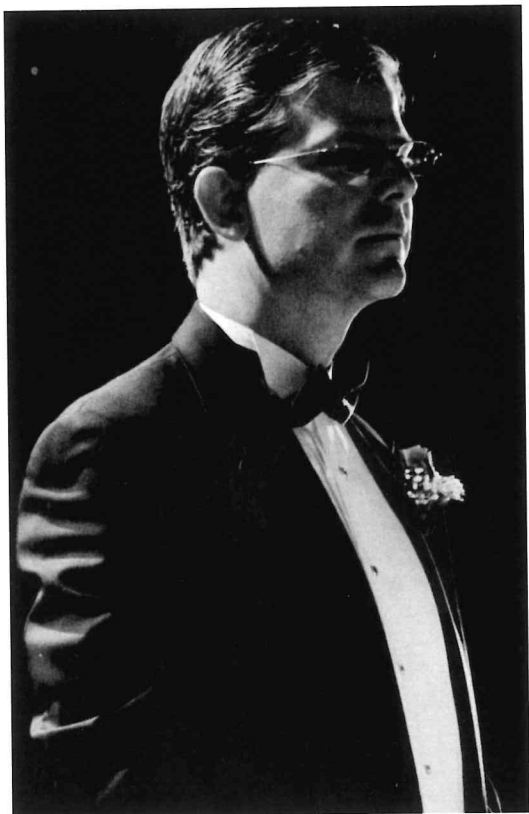

Welcome to the 2010 Instrumental Pops Concert. This year our theme is "Epic."

2010 started off with floods and evacuations. As we prepared for our festivals we were hampered by epic rains with projected flooding and late night calls for evacuations. We were faced with the truly epic struggle to ignore all emotional and physical distractions and focus on festival season. String Orchestra and Wind Ensemble tackled tough music while Jazz Band continued their epic year of huge senior leadership. Jazz Band received the highest unanimous superior ratings in the history of CV at the Fullerton College Jazz Festival while Symphony Orchestra continued their domination at both District and Regional festivals. They were called "One of the Elite Ensembles" by an adjudicator. Concert Band had their own Epic struggle in just fitting over 100 students in the music room! Did I mention we also took over 130 people to Hawaii for Spring Break?

As you can see, this year has been beyond the ordinary in both size of obstacles and scope of activity so it is only fitting that we end the year with a Pops Concert of Epic Proportions! Get ready for heart pounding, intense and emotionally charged music.

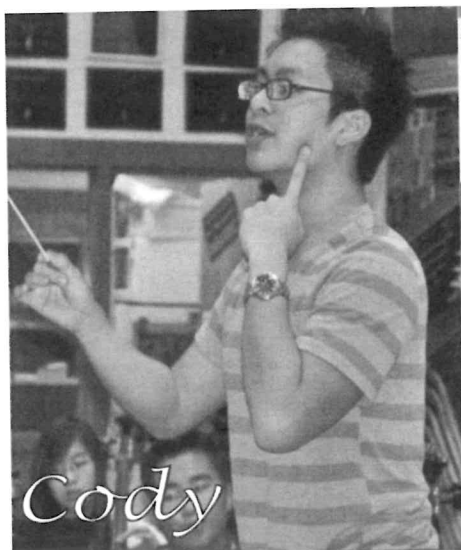

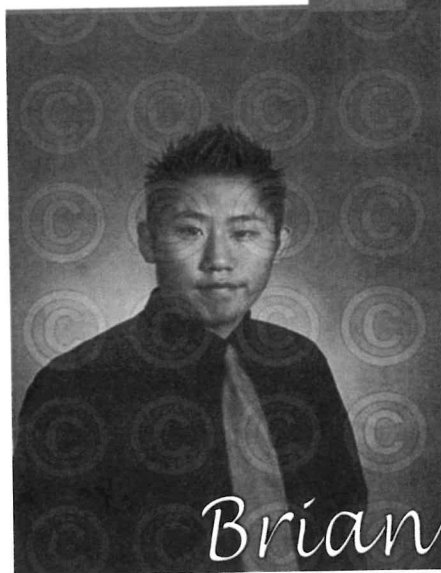

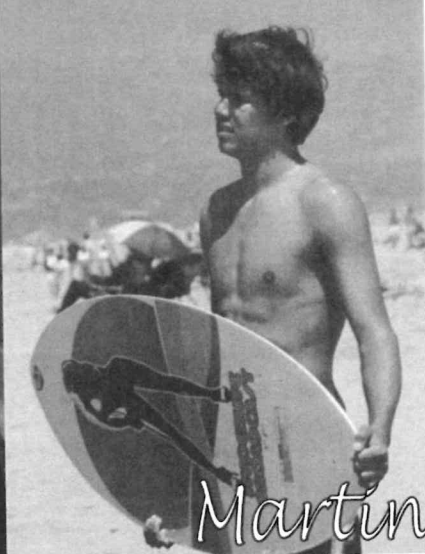

A-Team

The A-Team was a top Commando unit that was betrayed and placed in jail. They later busted out and became soldiers of fortune for hire!

Mr. "T" - "Fool, nuff said."

Schindler's List

Oskar Schindler is credited with saving over a thousand Jewish lives. He protected them by employing them as factory workers, using his personal fortune to keep up the guise and to bribe officials.

Coldplay On Stage (Clocks / Lost! / Viva La Vida)

Due to the group's immense popularity and record sales, it won the World's Best Selling Artist/England in 2005 and the World's Best Rock Act and the World's Best Selling Recording Act in 2008. One of their songs also was downloaded 2 million times in the week starting 28 April 2008, entering the Guinness Book of World Records as the "Most Downloaded Free Track in a Week."

Hunchback

The Hunchback of Notre Dame is a novel published in 1831 by French novelist Victor Hugo. It started a Gothic revival and a movement toward preserving historical sites. Most of the general public know of the Disney animated film that is derived from the book.

Epic stories, traditions, and music in myth and history

Hunting Wabbits

It is a homage to all the frenetic animated cartoons of the past.

Pirates of the Caribbean: At World's End

The adventures of Jack Sparrow and his pirate crew are continued in this film. The most expensive film ever made, not adjusted for inflation. The budget ran at \$300,000,000.

Stevie Wonder Medley

He has recorded more than thirty U.S. top ten hits and received twenty-two Grammy Awards, the most ever given to a male solo artist.

James Bond

The name's Bond...James Bond.
Possibly the most well-known British agent in the best selling novels by Ian Fleming and numerous films.

Finale from William Tell Overture

The "William Tell Overture" is the instrumental introduction to the opera *William Tell* by Gioachino Rossini. There has been repeated use (and sometimes parody) of this overture in popular media, most famously for being the theme music for the *Lone Ranger* radio and television shows.

John Williams Trilogy (Star Wars / Jurassic Park / Raiders March)

A tribute to John Williams who is arguably the best and most prolific modern film composer.

What makes this music Epic?

Jupiter

In Gustav Holst's symphony "The Planets", each movement is intended to convey ideas and emotions associated with the influence of the planets on the psyche. The Jupiter movement is also called "Bringer of Jollity."

Finale from the Firebird suite

Leopold Stokowski recorded The Firebird Suite by Igor Stravinsky eight times, more than any other conductor.

Casus Belli

Casus Belli is a Latin expression meaning the justification for acts of war. In historical context, a government would explain their reasons for going into war, explaining the action as a last resort.

Blue Rondo à la Turk

Dave Brubeck is regarded as one of the most prominent jazz musicians of the 20th century, due to his innovation compositions and time signatures, epitomized in his composition Blue Rondo à La Turk.

Soul Vaccination

Tower of Power - Funky, "in your face" charts. Bringing "Funk" Mainstream

Smooth

The song won three Grammy Awards, including Record of the Year, Song of the Year, and Best Pop Collaboration with Vocals. According to some charting standards, "Smooth" is Billboard's most popular song of all time. When combining total sales during the entire time the song has charted and its 12 weeks at No. 1, "Smooth" ranks higher than any other. The song was the last number one hit of the 1990s, and the first #1 song of the 20th century.

Titanic

At the time of her construction, Titanic the ship was the largest passenger steamship in the world and ended as one of the deadliest peacetime maritime disasters in history. The movie, however, won 11 academy awards. In addition, a deep-sea camera system, capable of withstanding the water pressure at the depth of the sea bed where the Titanic sank, had to be developed in order to allow filming from outside the sub.

Tragic story of a disfigured man who lives in the cellar of an Opera House.
