From Killer Tomatoes, Dragons, and Wizards, to Space, Vampires, and Superstition, the songs we play tonight connect with our emotions to tell fantastical stories that are magical and mystical and, I hope, entertaining. This year has been filled with many wonderful moments in the Instrumental Music Program and I want to thank you all for a stellar year. We've made new friends, played new music, and continued our important musical journey.
