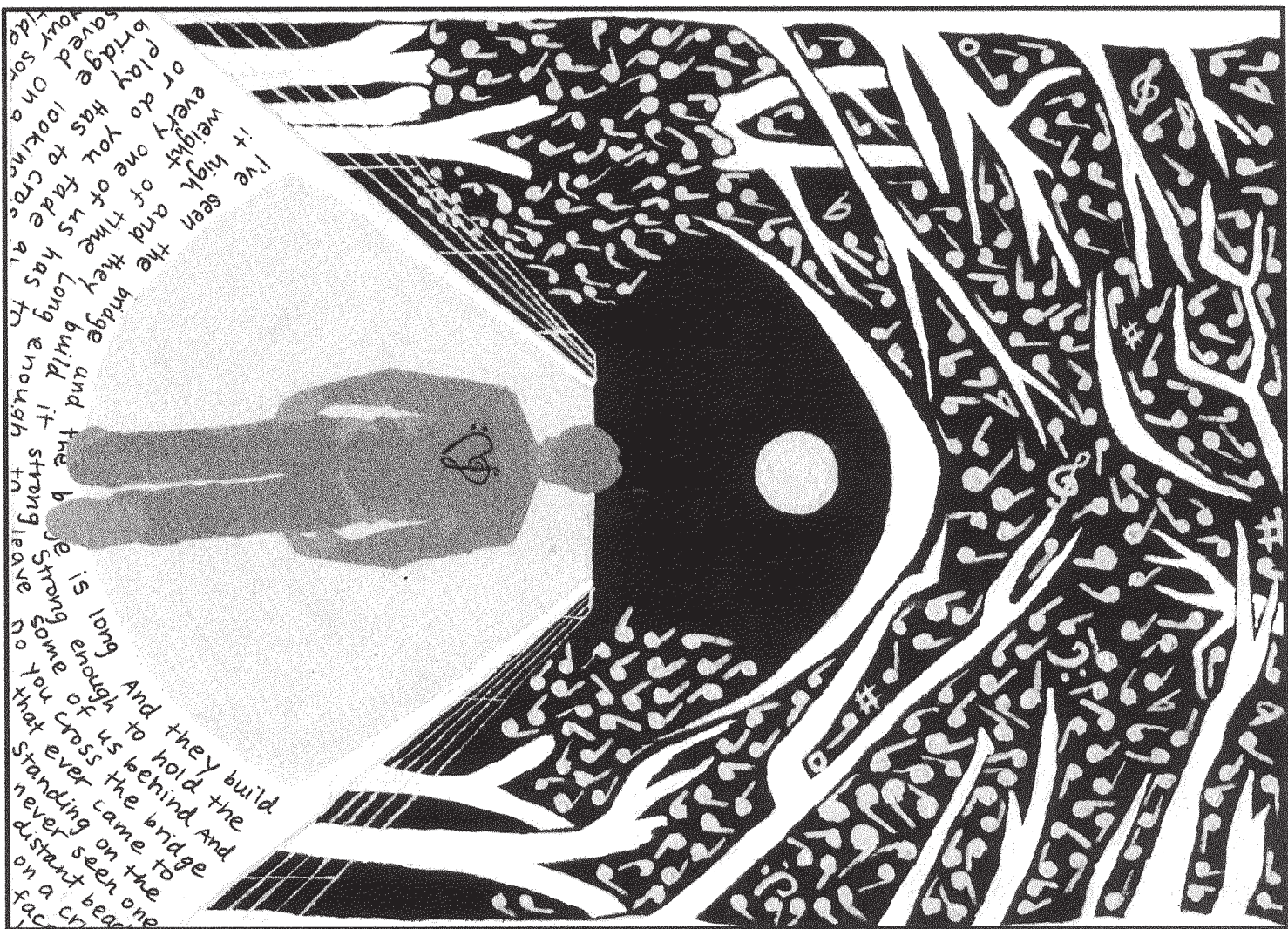

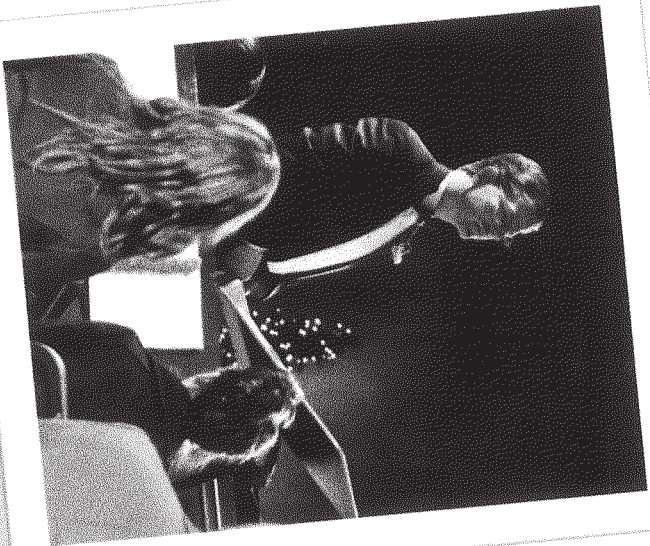

Welcome to the 2012 CVHS Instrumental Pops Concert. We've had a very successful year both musically and emotionally. Webster's Dictionary defines success as "favorable accomplishment," "prosperity," and "one who has achieved success." It is related to the word succession that Webster's defines as an "act of following in order." When choosing our theme this year, I thought of our journey as a group and our many successes, as well as the struggles that sometimes preceded them. Since Dr. Who is a story about a person who explores the universe via a time machine I thought it a fitting end to our concert, "The Places You Will Go."
