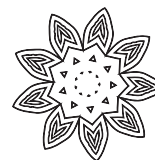

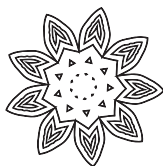

**W**elcome to the **Crescenta Valley High School Instrumental Music Spring Concert.** This concert highlights all of our talented performing groups as they prepare for Spring Festivals. Although this music may not be as familiar as what we play during the Winter or Pops Concert, this style of music usually evokes images which allow our young musicians to tell stories while exploring musical concepts such as phrasing, dynamics, articulation, and intonation.

Festival season is a time when our groups travel to other schools and perform music for judges who listen and make comments while looking at the conductor's score. The judges know exactly what our musicians should be playing and, many times, the judges have heard or played these selections with their own music groups. What I especially enjoy about Festivals is that there is no "competition." There is no 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or last place. There is only a "ranking" which establishes how well each group performs. Groups can earn a Superior (the highest), Excellent, Good, Fair, or Poor. With the ranking also comes feedback from the judges, which is both written and spoken. We receive CD's or audio files with constructive comments on our playing. Those comments help us to improve our performance.

**At tonight's concert, we plan to entertain you with "Superior" performances of selections as diverse as:**

**"Siege of Badon Hill,"** a piece loosely based on the Legend of King Arthur.

**"My Funny Valentine,"** a wonderful ballad of admiration and love.

**"New World Symphony,"** a standard Classical piece depicting America as the new world with majestic musical themes and curious interludes.

**"Mt. Everest,"** a piece inspired by the world's tallest mountain and man's adventuring spirit in conquering it.

**"Cincopations,"** a fun piece with "5" as the theme. This piece is a tango in 5/4.

**"Carneval Del Sol,"** an energetic piece which represents the flavor of Latin America's biggest festival in the Pacific Northwest.
