



## The 2018 CVIM Foundation Scholarship

The Crescenta Valley Instrumental Music Foundation Scholarship was established on May 26, 2017, when the first scholarships were awarded at our annual End of Year Banquet.

A scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to each of two graduating seniors who have been active in an instrumental music performing group or groups at Crescenta Valley High School. Applications are not limited to declared music majors, but seniors must be continuing their education at a college or university with the intention of participating in a musical performing group, on or off campus.

### Foundation Scholarship requirements:

- Graduating senior from Crescenta Valley High School
- Member of a CVHS instrumental music performing group for a minimum of 3 out of 4 years and must also be currently enrolled in a CVHS instrumental music class. If transferring from another high school, you must have been in an instrumental music group at that high school.
- Minimum GPA of 3.0  
A current unofficial transcript or a signed confirmation from your counselor must be attached to this application.
- Completed CVIM Foundation Scholarship application
- Essay Prompt: Please attach an essay of approximately one page describing how the CVHS instrumental music program has specifically affected your high school education and experience overall, and how music in general has played a role in your development
