
Tonight the Crescenta Valley High School Instrumental Music Program presents a concert filled with songs from musicals. It's an eclectic collection with songs from classic musicals like *The King and I* and *Porgy and Bess*, as well as movie musicals such as *The Wizard of Oz*, *West Side Story* and *The Wiz*. We have music from some modern classics such as *Cats*, *Phantom of the Opera* and *Les Misérables*, as well as the recent Broadway smash *Dear Evan Hansen*.

Our students have had another exemplary year. We started with the Marching Band placing 4th in their competitive division in CSBC with *The Planets*, earning numerous High Music, High Auxiliary, and High Percussion awards. Then Concert Band, String Orchestra and Symphony Orchestra all earned Superiors at SCSBOA Regionals during Festival season. In fact, one judge expressed that she had not heard a high school Symphony Orchestra better than ours in her vast years of judging! Our Jazz Band, rebuilding due to a large senior class last year, didn't skip a beat and ended up earning Superiors at its last few festivals.

My hope for you tonight is to enjoy our music and have it inspire you to go out and see live musicals. It's so important to support live music and the arts! We live so close to many world class venues. Be it the Walt Disney Hall, The Pantages Theater or the Hollywood Bowl, there are many choices for live entertainment in Los Angeles.
